

1. Place outside trash cans and recycling bins inside the garage

2. Either park cars in a garage or far enough away from the home that I can capture the photos without any vehicles being in the shot.

3. Hide any tissues boxes, soap bottles, dish rags, refrigerator magnets

4. Remove everything from bathroom counter tops

5. Ceiling fans OFF, all lights ON

6. Remove any traces of pets (dog beds, kennels, food dishes). Clean dog waste from yard.

7. De-clutter kitchen counter-tops, leave only a couple items or small appliances. Preferably no knife blocks.

8. I rarely photograph insides of garages or closets, you can use these spaces to hide clutter or items you're not wanting to be in the photos.

9. If possible, it is always very beneficial to photograph a laundry area. Do as much as you can to make this area look appealing.

10. Hide all interior trash cans (kitchen, bathrooms, bedrooms). I will happily move them for you if you're not able to find a convenient place to put them.
